An aid in the prevention of burns due to excessively high water heater temperature setting

Wisconsin Statute 196.373 (2), created by 1987 Wisconsin Act 102 of the state legislature, requires that every public utility providing gas or electric service within Wisconsin include in its periodic billing to customers, a statement "recommending that water heater thermostats be set **no higher than 125 degrees Fahrenheit** in order to prevent severe burns and unnecessary energy consumption".

Please check with your water heater appliance supplier or local serviceman if you wish help in determining the setting of the thermostat on your water heater.

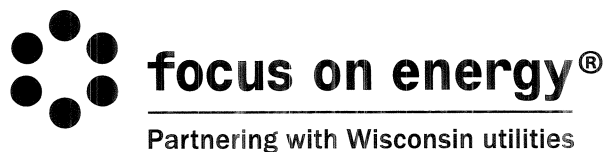
